



„The **Teutonic Order**, whose members called themselves "Brothers of the German House of St. Mary in Jerusalem" after the former German hospital in Jerusalem, was founded in 1190 in Acre, initially as a hospital brotherhood and since 1198 also as a knightly community for the protection of pilgrims in the Holy Land. The Teutonic Order arrived in Bozen in 1202, where a hospital and a church were built near the Eisack River at the base of Mount Virgl. Since the location was repeatedly threatened by floods, the Order acquired the lower noble tower of Weggenstein in the village district of Bozen in 1392.

In 1400, the Order permanently moved its official residence to the new location, which had since been elevated to a territorial command within the Teutonic Orders "Ballei" "An der Etsch und im Gebirge".

In 1932, the **Collegium Marianum**, a boarding school for pupils and students, was established.

During World War II, American bombings damaged the church and parts of the new location in 1944, particularly the "Knöringenturm". On the occasion of the 800th anniversary of the Teutonic Order, the original baroque condition of the ensemble was restored and a chapel was consecrated in the rebuilt "Knöringenturm" in 1991.

Today, members of the Teutonic Order are active both in pastoral and in elderly care. Since 2016, the Collegium Marianum has exclusively housed University's students."

The student hostel Collegium Marianum in Bozen

The Collegium Marianum is managed by the Teutonic Order and it is situated in a quiet residential quarter of Bozen/Bolzano, just a few minutes of walk from the city center, the University and the Konservatorium Claudio Monteverdi.



Assignment of accommodation

Accommodation is allocated by the University Welfare Office (the office takes part of the public administration of the Autonomous Province of Bolzano).

Students who are regularly enrolled at a higher education institution in South Tyrol, or who are completing an internship in this context, are entitled to submit the request for an accommodation in a student hostel.

Rooms – furnishings

The student home Collegium Marianum offers single rooms with private bathroom as well as single rooms with a shared bathroom.

All the rooms inside the student home are bright and kindly furnished.



The **rooms** are fully furnished and are equipped as follows:

Bed, mattress, mattress cover, bedside cabinet, wardrobe, shelf, desk, chair, internet (WIFI), TV access.

The use of the mattress cover is obligatory.

Please bring your own bed linen, pillows, blankets etc.

If desired, the following items can be purchased directly at reception at the student hostel Peter Rigler nearby: synthetic fiber blanket (50€), fitted sheet (17€), bed linen set consisting of pillowcase and duvet cover (40€), towels (6€-10€).



Bathroom:

hand basin, cupboard with drawers, mirror, toilet, shower, towel rail.

Shared bathroom:

hand basin, mirror, toilets, shower cabins, shelf.



Common rooms in the student hostel

There are two big and fully furnished shared kitchens, which are equipped as follows: modern ceramic glass cooktops, baking oven, sink, microwave, fridge compartment for each student, tables and chairs.

Each student brings its own dishes (crocery, pots etc.). There are enough kitchen cabinets to store your own dishes and foodstuff.

There is a music room as well as a TV room for get-together at your disposal. The small but comfortable library gives you access to the terrace and it is ideal for your studies or for a talk with the other housemates.

Who prefers sport activities can use the common rooms at the student home Peter Rigler nearby, like the fitness room (with high quality equipment), the playing rooms (billiards, ping pong, table soccer, darts), as well as the outdoor volleyball and soccer field.





The laundry room is equipped with modern washing machines and dryers. In addition, a drying room is available.

One wash cycle costs € 3,00 and one drying cycle costs € 2,00. Washing machines and dryers are working with coins.

The monthly rent includes heating, electricity, water, waste disposal fees, as well as a weekly cleaning service.

Monthly rent doesn't include:

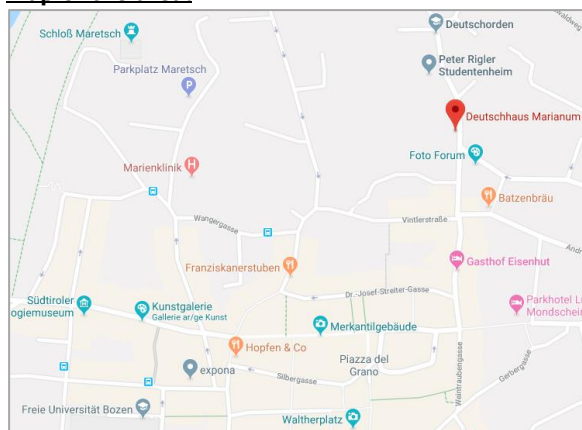
- lump sum for the coverage of extraordinary damages (€ 25,00 – to be paid upon arrival, once a year)
- bedclothes etc.

There is a parking area for bicycles in the inner courtyard. Part of it is roofed.

A parking space in the garage of the student hostel Peter Rigler nearby can be rented for € 60,00/month, subject to availability.

The use of the Internet (Wifi) is free of charge.
